As we announced in our last update, God opened doors for our school to finally re-open, even amidst the turmoil the country is still enduring. Though our location is distanced from the source of most of the gang activity, our teachers take a great risk every day just by leaving their homes and coming to work. Some of them live right in the cities where the danger is worst. Please keep them and their families in your prayers. We are so thankful because of your partnership we were able to make payroll for them last month, as well. We know the situation is dire when our employees are willing to risk their lives in order to make a living to provide for their families. We are so thankful for teachers and a school director who prioritize the children and their education, even above their own safety.

Please also pray fervently for Haiti as a whole: for peaceful solutions and a return to security for the nation. In all our years of service (and Wilckly's entire life in Haiti) we have never experienced its current state of instability. This is the first time we have ever been told by our people on the ground NOT to come back yet. Though we are in constant communication with them, guiding them in decisions and ministry steps, we desperately miss them and our home.

We know, though, that God's timing and His plan are best, and that though this season is not something we would have planned for ourselves nor ever wanted, His Word is still going out and it WILL accomplish its purpose. We have been encouraged by many who have received that word from Him through us and made sure to tell us what a difference that has made in their lives. We are so thankful for these reminders that no matter the season, there WILL be a harvest because GOD is the planter.

Family Update


